A Letter from the Director

Welcome to Girl Scout Camp! I am so excited to share this year's summer program with you. No matter which session(s) your camper(s) attends, I know they will have a safe, fun, and formative experience, shared with once-in-a-lifetime friends, and led by dedicated role models.

Thoroughly review this guide, the caregiver guide, as well as the information provided on the Summer Camp webpage at www.gsctx.org/summercamp, as they are essential in navigating your camper's session options, and important updates.

New this year, we are implementing a camp lottery with multiple session preferences to enhance the registration process as well as alleviate specific pain points experienced during last year's camp registration.

Additionally, we have adjusted check-in and check-out times for overnight camps to earlier in the day. This will protect campers and staff from prolonged sun and heat exposure. Review the caregiver guide for additional information.

Due to limited capacity, overnight camp registration is limited to one session of overnight camp per camper, this includes waitlisted sessions, for the first several weeks of registration to allow as many people as possible the opportunity to attend camp.

As summer approaches, please check the Summer Camp page of our website for important updates and information and remember current physical and immunization records are required to attend overnight camp.

Registration

Girl Scouts of Central Texas is improving the summer camp registration process by providing two session selection processes designed to remove the pressure of time-specific registration.

New Camp Registration Lottery: A randomized lottery system with multiple session preferences will allow us to place your camper in the best session available based on your requested criteria. Sibling and buddy requests are welcome; however, both campers must indicate the same buddy to be considered.

Website Registration: Log in using your existing MyGS username and password to register for summer camp using gsEvents.

Registration Dates

Registration for all 2024 camps is accessed online through the GSCTX website at www.gsctx.org/summercamp.

- **January 11:** Overnight camp registration lottery opens.
- **January 21:** Registration lottery closes.
- **January 30:** Lottery participants notified of placement.
- **February 12:** Online registration for Camp Texlake sessions open at 10:00 a.m.
- **February 13:** Online registration for Bluebonnet Shores Girl Scout Camp (previously Camp Kachina) sessions open at 10:00 a.m.
- **February 14:** Online registration for council-led day camps open at 10:00 a.m.
- **March 4:** Registration for overnight camp opens for additional sessions. Reservations will be limited to one session of overnight camp per camper, including waitlists, until this time.
- **March 4:** Registration for overnight camp opens for Girl Scouts registered outside of Central Texas. Registration is limited to GSCTX members only until this time.



Campers who register for more than one week of overnight camp before March 4 will have **all additional sessions aside from their first registration cancelled without notification.** This includes waitlists. Registering to be added to a waitlist is equivalent to registering for an open week of camp.

If you mistakenly register for the wrong camp session, do not re-register for another session. Contact customer care to move your registration to the correct session. All transfers will incur a \$25 transfer fee when moving payment from one camp session to another. Please double check your information before submitting your registration. Online Registration for Camp

Lottery Registration: Visit the 2024 Overnight Summer Camp Lottery webpage at www.gsctx.org/camplottery from January 11-21, 2024, to provide your camper's information and up to five camp session preferences. All entry forms received will be randomized, and buddy and sibling requests will be considered whenever possible. Lottery participants will receive an email on January 30, 2024, informing you of the session your camper has either been registered for or waitlisted in. You will have a short period of time to request changes if this session no longer works for your schedule.

Website Registration: Visit the Summer Camp webpage at www.gsctx.org/summercamp on or after the day your preferred camp session opens for registration. Keep in mind that many sessions may already be full or have limited availability.

If a troop leader wants to register members for camp using troop funds, please contact customercare@gsctx.org.

A \$75 deposit is required at the time of initial registration to hold the spot. This includes waitlist registrations. If a camper does not get moved into the session for which they are waitlisted, the deposit will be refunded. All other deposits are non-refundable. Remember, you may only register for more than one camp session, including waitlisted sessions, beginning March 4, 2024.

Last-Chance Deadline: 21 days prior to the camp session start date.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 30 days prior to the camp session start date.

While the \$75 deposit is due at the time of registration, 50% of your total camp balance will be due no later than six weeks prior to your camp's start date. You may log into your MyGS account at any time to make payments, in any amount, up to the full balance. Select Pay Now on the balance due bar that appears at the top of your account screen, enter the amount you'd like to pay, and enter your payment information. Paying online is the quickest and most secure method to pay your camp balance. If you prefer to contact customer care with your credit card information, we will accept payment over the phone. Payment may also be mailed by check to the council address. No new registrations will be allowed after the posted last registration date (21 days before the camp session's start date).

Using Program Credits to pay for camp.

If your camper is working to earn a free week of camp* through the Girl Scout Cookie Program, they must register for camp following the standard camp registration process to reserve their spot and should plan to enter the lottery or sign up early to secure their preferred session. All camp registrations require a \$75 deposit, paid by credit card, at the time of registration to hold the camp session. We do not accept Program Credits to pay the deposit. Once the Girl Scout Cookie Program is complete and all rewards are confirmed, campers who elect a free week of camp will be refunded the deposit paid.

*Camps are labeled as standard or specialty camp in the camp guide. Girl Scouts who sell 1,250+ boxes of Girl Scout Cookies are eligible for a free week of standard camp. Girl Scouts who sell 1,500+ boxes of Girl Scouts Cookies are eligible to upgrade to any camp, including specialty camps. Girl Scouts who earned and selected a free week of standard camp and want to attend a specialty camp must select the 425 Program Credits option and complete the Program Credit Request Form by visiting www.gsctx.org/programcredits to apply these to their camp balance.

Securing financial assistance to attend camp.

We believe every Girl Scout deserves to experience the magic of camp and we're happy to help if it is needed. Please visit www.gsctx.org/fa to complete a Financial Partnership Application. Typically, financial partnership covers up to 50 percent of camp fees. When applying for a financial partnership, follow the standard camp registration process to reserve your spot. All camp registrations require a \$75 deposit paid at the time of registration to hold the spot. Awarded financial partnership will be used to help pay the balance.

Camp confirmation communication.

Lottery participants will receive an email on January 30, 2024, informing you of the session your camper has either been registered for or waitlisted in. Website registrants will receive an automated confirmation email. If you do not receive the confirmation email, please contact customer care at customercare@gsctx.org.

As soon as you complete your registration, your camp session will appear in the My Events section of your MyGS account. Clicking on the camp session name will display important information about the camp, including location, dates, times, and our cancellation and transfer policies. Scroll down to Additional Documentation to see links to the required health forms packet that will need to be turned in at camp check-in, as well as the Summer Camp Caregiver Guide that provides further information about camp policies and expectations. Additional information will be sent via email at regular intervals as the camp season approaches.

Health forms and waivers.

Once registered, you will have access to the Summer Camp Caregiver Guide as well as required health forms and waivers by logging in to your MyGS account at mygs.girlscouts.org and selecting My Events from the left-hand navigation. Links to these documents will be found under Additional Documentation. All forms are due at camp check in. Additional information will be sent via email at regular intervals as the camp season approaches.

Cancellation and transfer policies.

Our cancellation and transfer policies can be found on the Summer Camp webpage at www.gsctx.org/summercamp. Cancellations and transfers will be subject to a fee.

Choosing a Camp Session

To help ensure a great camper experience, register your camper for a session that is appropriate for their age and Girl Scout level. Grade levels are noted by their acronym in each camp session in the Summer Camp Guide. Choose an age-appropriate session based on **the grade your camper will be entering for fall 2024**. For example, if your camper is currently in grade 3 and will be entering grade 4 in fall of 2024, the camper should register into a grade 4, Junior program, even if they have not officially bridged.

- D: Daisies* – Entering grade 1 in fall 2024
- B: Brownies – Entering grades 2 and 3
- J: Juniors – Entering grades 4 and 5
- C: Cadettes – Entering grades 6, 7, and 8
- S: Seniors – Entering grades 9 and 10
- A: Ambassadors – Entering grades 11 and 12

*Campers should complete kindergarten before attending camp.

Selecting camp buddies.

At overnight camp, we place our campers into cabins by program. Therefore, campers do not need to request buddies. If campers want to ensure they are together at camp, they should register into the same program.

We discourage troops and large groups (four or more) from attending camp together. Camp provides campers the opportunity to make new friends, take safe risks, and test their independence unburdened by the expectations of their day-to-day relationships and affiliations. We find troops who attend sessions together as a large group are less likely to achieve these benefits.

Living unit assignments.

Each program's living unit and a brief description of that program are listed in this guide. More information about each unit, including photos, can be found at www.gsctx.org/camps. Please be sure to choose a program with an assigned living unit that meets your camper's needs, especially if they require certain amenities such as air conditioning or electricity for medical conditions. Campers cannot be assigned to a living unit different from their programs' assigned space.

Ensuring your camper's success at camp.

To attend Girl Scouts of Central Texas Summer Camp, campers must be able to meet the following essential functions:

- Move independently from place to place.
- Independently meet personal needs (bathing, toileting, dressing, diet management, etc.).
- Effectively interact in group-based program content.
- Exhibit enough awareness to capably self-manage chronic illness. A camper must be aware of their own dietary restrictions, medication requirements, and potential restrictions on physical activity, and be able to alert counselors when they need additional assistance.

Caregivers of campers with special needs or unique habits should contact customercare@gsctx.org in advance of their week at camp so they can receive the best placement and appropriate accommodations.

Camp session programming.

All camps are designed to provide a traditional Girl Scout Summer Camp experience with a twist. The twist is the theme of the program you choose at registration. For example, Harriet Potter is not intended to be a fully immersive Harry Potter camp, but rather a week of traditional camp with a Harry Potter spin to it. Our specialty camps, like horse programs or SCUBA diving, spend a lot of time doing traditional activities as well. If you have questions about the program for which you intend to register, contact us at customercare@gsctx.org.

All overnight campers are invited to take part in traditional camp activities like campfire, songs, arts and crafts, and games. Weather permitting, overnight campers can swim each day at camp. Each program listed in this guide includes some basic information about planned activities. However, we promote girl-led opportunities, and we offer a certain amount of freedom for campers as a group to choose additional program options during their stay. To guarantee your camper will engage in certain activities like sailing, kayaking, or high ropes, make sure you choose a program that lists those activities in the description. Love horses? Make sure to choose a horse program!

Kodosky Day Camp



Campers will do badge work and earn fun patches, make crafts, participate in STEM activities, and learn camp songs and games, all while making new friends and enjoying air conditioning!

Kodosky Day Camp is girl-led. The leaders, our Cadette, Senior, and Ambassador Camp Aides, are trained and screened by the Kodosky Summer Day Camp Manager and supervised by adult staffers and volunteers. Campers are divided into groups based on Girl Scout level.

Camp runs from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. each day with an Extended-Care option available from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. for an additional fee.

Selecting an on-level horse program.

Use extra care to register your camper for a horse program that is appropriate for their level of riding skill. It is not safe for campers or the horses when a camper participates in a program that they are not properly prepared for. All horse programs include one to one-and-a-half hours per day at the barn with the horses during each full day at camp.

Beginner – Campers who have never ridden a horse, have only ridden a few times in their life, only ride a few times per year, or have less than five years of experience on horses are beginner riders.

Intermediate – Campers who have ridden and can control a horse at a trot, ride several times per year (30 plus days per year), or have been attending private riding lessons for more than one month are intermediate riders. Riders who do not demonstrate proper intermediate skills may be moved to a beginner program for their safety.

Advanced – Campers who take private riding lessons, have ridden consistently for more than six months per year, have ridden consistently (10 plus days a month) for more than five years, or have ridden and controlled a horse at a canter in an arena or on a trail ride are advanced riders. A letter or documentation of riding ability may be required for advanced riding programs. Riders who do not demonstrate proper advanced riding skills may be moved to an intermediate or beginner program for their safety.

Girl Scout leadership programs combine exciting summer camp activities with experiential leadership training, resulting in a unique, fun, and high-quality adventure for Girl Scouts who dream big! Leadership programs are progressive and are designed based on the ages and development of the campers. Each session of a particular program will include similar foundational skills, but as every week's campers are different, those who attend multiple sessions will have the opportunity to practice a wider range of skills. Programs can be attended multiple times. We encourage campers to try leadership programs at different camps to also experience a variety of work environments and styles. Each level of leadership program teaches new skills that are intended to be taken back after camp and applied at the troop, service unit, or day camp level. Do not sign up for progressive levels of leadership programs within the same summer.

Previous leadership experience can sometimes be substituted for participation in a leadership program level. For example, campers who have worked as camp aides at day camp for multiple sessions may be able to advance directly to the Counselor-in-Training program based on their experience.
